SAFE WASTEWATER

OUR WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IN COMBINATION WITH GOOD BACTERIA THAT WE ADD TO IT SENDS OUR FACTORY WASTEWATER COMPLETELY HARMLESS INTO NATURE. THE GOAL FOR 2021 IS TO MAKE THAT WATER EVEN SAFER BY FILTERING IT ENOUGH TO MAKE IT SAFE FOR IRRIGATION OF OUR FACTORY FARM.



SUSTAINABLE DYEING

WE ALMOST ALWAYS USE DYE-SUBLIMATION PRINTERS AND CALENDERS WHEN COLOURING RECYCLED POLYESTER FABRICS. THIS METHOD SAVES INCREDIBLE AMOUNTS OF WATER COMPARED TO THE TRADITIONAL DYEING ONE. NO WASTEWATER IS CREATED AND THE ONLY WASTE IS PAPER, THAT GETS RECYCLED.

PLANNING AHEAD

In early 2021, we'll start relying 100% on solar energy. To ensure it's done throughout the year, we bought batteries that will store the energy for the cloudy days.

As soon as travelling becomes what it was before the pandemic, we'll roll out our factory visits programme! Textile and fashion students, clients both present and potential will be able to spend days at our factory-grounds apartments, following the garment production process from A to Z. This includes access to all departments and processes as well as the factory canteen that will serve food prepared from groceries made on our own farm.
